## Terrorist & Bomb Threat Policy

The possible activities that constitute a terrorist act are wide and varied: They could include, but are not limited to: Bomb threat, fire, receiving a suspicious package, release of hazardous chemicals, release of biological agents, a radiological incident, hostage taking. *(Note: The removal of a child may be the result of a family court issue – see Access to Students Policy.)*

The school shall ensure that it has well thought out plans to deal with potential terrorist acts, such as Bomb threats.
